

#### **JUMP-OFF POINTS:**

#### A. Japas - Regular Route

Location: Japas, Bobok-Bisal, Bokod, Benguet

Distance from Baguio City: 60 Kilometers

Trip Hours: 2 hrs.— 2.5 hrs. Distance of Jump-off to Mt.

Purgatory: 10.5 Kms.

#### B. Pethal - Challenge Route

Location: Pethal, Ekip, Bokod, Benguet Distance from Baguio City: 59 Kilometers Trip Hours: 2 hrs.— 3 hrs.

Distance of Jump-off to Mt. Purgatory: 15.5 Kms



### Mt. Mangagew

(a.k.a. Mangakew) Elevation: 1705 MASL

The first mountain peak and the Japas jump-off Point. This area is a settlement for some of the local folks.




#### Mt. Pack

(a.k.a Mt. Banshila)- 2310 MASL

One of the highest mountains of Bokod where the long trail of mossy forest begins.

# TRAVERSE MAP





Formerly known as line 7, it was once a spar tree site (jump pole for tramline of the Benguet Corporation). It was named Mt. Purgatory because of the feeling of isolation due to coldness & darkness (thick vegetation) likened to the description of purgatory.



# Mt. Bakian

Some of the Bokod native folks situated their abode in the area. (Cottages located in the area are also used as accommodation for tourists)



# Mt. Tinengan

Situated on the mountain's belt, the trail is considered as one of the challenging pathways in completing the Mt. Purgatory climb adventure. Due to its steep terrain, tourists/hikers are advised to take precautionary measures while on their way.



# Mt. Komkompol

Elevation: 2325 MASL

It is the highest point of Mt. Purgawwtory Trail. It provides a magnificent view of Mt. Pulag, Kabayan and nearby Mt.. Salingsingan during good weather conditions.



# Mt. Tangbao

-2200 MASL

The mountain features a flat grassland and provides a spectacular view of Benguet mountain ranges.
